Cost of Care

Fees collected at the time of service go toward the operation of the school's clinics and make it possible to offer ongoing services at reasonable prices.

Accept most insurance plans, MasterCard and Visa, or personal checks; however, do not accept Medicaid or Medicare. Payment is due at time of service.

CADE fees for endodontic and periodontic services are generally 50-60% less than fees charged in private practices in the St. Louis area.

New Dental Patient Appointments

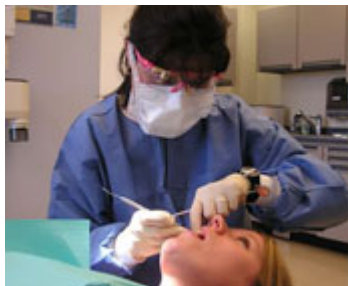
A person wishing to become a dental patient MUST call the health center to get their name on a waiting list. Please call the Carondelet center (314) 678-2971 or the Forest Park Southeast center (314) 371-0336. As appointments become available, people on the waiting list are called in the order that their name appears on the waiting list to schedule an appointment.

A new dental patient appointment includes a thorough examination of the teeth, gums, and oral cancer soft tissue screening, as well as any necessary x-rays. Patients are then scheduled for actual dental treatment on their next appointment.

Most private insurance plans accepted. Patients without insurance are served on a sliding fee based upon income and family size.

All dental patients MUST be a current ACTIVE patient of the physicians at Family Care Health Centers.

Patients needing specialized services such as orthodontics, complicated oral surgery, limited endodontics or fixed prosthetics are referred to specialists.

Grace Hill's dental staff knows that dental care is important to overall systemic integrity, and that good oral health is necessary for proper chewing and speaking, as well as aesthetics. Recent findings have shown that poor oral conditions can contribute to the aggravation of other conditions such as diabetes and heart disease. Regular oral screenings can also detect the presence of cancers and other systemic conditions which may not yet be identified by a routine physical exam. Good oral health should begin as early as one to three years of age in order to address the importance of the primary teeth and establish a pattern of routine dental visits. Towards that end, staff have instituted systems to encourage all Grace Hill pediatric and prenatal patients to see the dentist at the time of their primary care visit.

Medicaid:
